



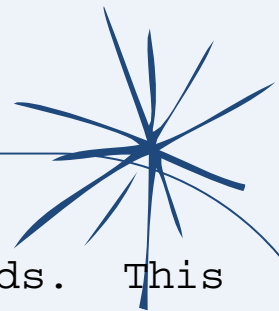
Economic, Social and Environmental

Factors: Pioneros SIFE will create seminars and workshops focused on entrepreneurial concepts, which will attract the potential entrepreneurs and keep the current entrepreneurs. With the seminars and workshops we will transfer valuable knowledge that will help them in their business strategies. Another significant business strategy for this project is the approval of various economic proposals to install solar panels at their facilities.

Project Outcomes: The Incubator "Plaza" Jayuya Project pretends to impact the local community of Jayuya, first, and then, the communities of Utuado and Adjuntas. An estimated number of people is fifty(50) persons. It also pretends to have all the eleven(11) kiosks occupied.



Juan del Pueblo (Desde mi horno)



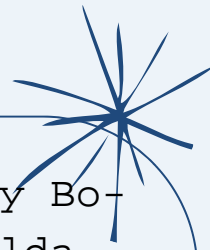
Juan del Pueblo(Desde mi horno) has various needs. This corporation operates as a combination of an individual corporation and a cooperative. Its owners are the employees themselves and local business entrepreneurs. This implies that the capital of the corporation is based upon volunteer human effort.

The corporation needs to enhance the number of bakery and pizza shops established in the impact areas. Secondly, it needs to motivate owners of current bakery and pizza shops and the new owners of recent established bakery and pizza shops to become members and owners of the corporation. Thirdly, the recycling of the left over cardboard of the corporation.

Economic, Social & Environmental Factors: Pioneros SIFE will promote the idea of this corporation thus obtaining more revenue, participants, and the creation of new entrepreneurial opportunities. This will be illustrated by the actual establishment of new bakery and pizza shops. On the other hand, through recycling promotion, seminars and workshops aimed at profit making of residue handling, the Pioneros SIFE will be promoting the recycling idea and making it a reality.

Project outcomes: This project will impact the surrounding areas of Jayuya and the neighboring towns of Barranquitas, Villalba, Adjuntas, Ciales, Utuado, Ponce, and Juana Díaz. Our forecast is that at least fifty persons will be impact.
